

STRATFORD ANNUAL TOWN CLEAN-UP!

The Town of Stratford will hold its annual Town Wide Community Clean Up Week from
Sunday April 28th, to Saturday, May 4th, 2024.

The melting snow reveals a winter's worth of litter along roadsides, and the Stratford Conservation Commission encourages all residents to help clean up the town during this week-long event. Those interested in participating can go to the transfer station during its normal hours to receive blue bags and instructions.

Saturday, May 4th is “Free Day” at the Stratford Transfer Station, a service offered for Stratford residents only and for trash originating in Stratford.

Acceptable items include construction and demolition debris (two pickup loads per family), tires (eight per family, no large truck or skidder tires), electronics (one TV and one computer per family, plus radios), and general items: one pickup load of debris; one couch, box spring, mattress or chair, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and microwaves, stoves, dryers and all white goods.

Items not accepted include asbestos, hazardous materials and related items. Hours of operation on Saturday May 4th are from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m., and those with questions may contact transfer station manager and selectman Charles Goulet, at 922-5535.
