

Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes May 7, 2026

Attending: Chris Caron, Chelsea Petereit
Meeting began at 5:30 pm

Minutes of April 9, 2026 meeting were read and approved by Chris, seconded by Chelsea

Christie Property (Town Forest), approximately 104 acres, was discussed. The Town Selectboard has requested an assessment of the property and suggestions for management. Chris met with the County forester and looked at the property. Their opinion was that there was value in the property. Chris has approached Northeast Conservation Services, who has been hired to complete the town's NRI, to add the assessment of the property to the NRI work, adding about \$6,000 to the cost. Jenny approved this plan via email and both Chelsea and Chris agreed. Chris will contact Peter Steckler at NCS. There will be a meeting with the Select Board to discuss in June.

The results of Clean Up Week were discussed. We know of 59 bags of trash that were collected as well as 2 AC units, 8 tires, a pallet, a headlight unit, a large piece of sheet metal, and an old highway sign. The transfer station appeared to be very busy on free dump day.
