BOG ROAD

“Hard Road to Travel” Class VI roads. Turning Class VI roads that are hard to travel into “trails.” July 17th we will re-discuss “Hard Road to Travel” and “Planning Board Regulation for Standards”

Bog Road: Charlie, Jim Lee, Clayton cleaned up the right of way and the town land which had belongings and trash from the Cavanaugh property. People living in trailers have been evicted see copies of eviction notices that were sent via the property owners.

Signs needed on the Bog Rd town property that state “No Dumping” and “Right of Way”

Letter to Florabelle- Meeting about removing trailers, remove at the cost of the town, details would be outlined closer to the time of the agreement. 9-11 Trailers on site at this time that need to be dealt with.

COVEY ROAD

The Covey road has sustained significant damage due to the heavy rains and flash flooding experienced recently.

Selectboard met with Jon Nugent at 12:30 today at Covey road to survey the damage. The overall consensus is that the upper town culvert couldn't handle the extreme water flow. The upper culvert needs repair and another 25" culvert needs to be added. The lower culvert should be adequate as long as it is not filled.

The Selectboard granted Jon Nugent permission to work on the Covey road and perform needed repairs.

Capital Reserve Fund may be utilized if FEMA doesn't declare an Emergency.
